

PLANTS THAT ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS

Hummingbirds are welcome guests to all gardens. Favorite plants include brightly colored flowers with a tubular form. As hummingbirds feed on the nectar (half of their weight daily) - they also injest the tiny insects (protein source) drawn to nectar. Additionally, as they feed, they carry pollen from one plant to another thus aiding pollination.
