Grapes are self-fertile. Only one cultivar is necessary.

Seedless Grapes

Cultivar	Season	Fruit Color/ Size	Description
Canadice Red	Early Fall	Red/Medium	Long, large clusters of medium-sized fruit. Excellent sweet and spicy flavor. Juice, jelly, wine.
Glenora Black	Late-Summer/Late-Fall	Blue-Black/ Medium	Well-filled clusters. Smooth thin skin with sweet and spicy flesh.
Himrod	Late-August	White/Medium	Highly productive vine bears crispy sweet fruit. Large clusters turn golden-yellow when fully ripe. Winter hardy and self-pollinating.
Suffolk Red	Early, Mid-Season	Red/Large	Medium to large clusters of pink to bright red, round firm berries with a mild spicy flavor. Hardy & productive.
Vanessa Red	Early-August	Red/Medium	This flame-type seedless grape yields oval grapes with a rich, deep-red color. Flesh is crisp and firm, and vines are vigorous and sub-zero hardy.
