SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: For mild climates only: 1 to 2 weeks after your average last frost date, and when soil temperature is at least 60°F. When to Start Inside: **Start Inside:** RECOMMENDED. 4 to 6 weeks before transplanting. Transplant when air temperature is 45°F or warmer, usually 1 to 2 weeks after your average last frost date. Ideal soil temperature for germination is 70°– 90°F.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days Seed Depth: 1/4" Seed Spacing: 24" Row Spacing: 36" Thinning: Not necessary.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: When the tomato is 1/2 green and 1/2 pink is when you can start harvesting. It will continue to ripen once picked. Keep in cool place to allow it to ripen without damaging the fruit or losing flavor or nutrients.
Fruit: Ace 55' has excellent, fresh tomato flavor and is a lower-acid tomato.
