This heirloom variety is one of the best tomatoes for growing anywhere. Bonny Best is a strong indeterminate vine that grows to 4' - 6' with a 20" - 24" spread. Bonny Best produces firm round tomatoes in clusters of medium sized 8 oz deep red fruit that are uniform in size.

SOWING & GROWING

Sow Outside: Not recommended.

Start Inside: Start indoors mid-March to early April. Plant 2-3 seeds 1/4" deep in good potting mix in 3"- 4" pots. It is best to keep tomato seedlings under very bright light to prevent plants from becoming too leggy. You may have to transplant seedlings to larger pots to allow for root growth.

Transplant: When transplanting outside, allow 24"-36" between plants and 36" between rows. Plant deeply to the first set of leaves after the risk of frost has passed. Thin to the strongest plant. The seeds require warm soil between 21-26°C (70-80° F). Warmer soils will promote faster germination.

Days to Emerge: 7-14 days Seed Depth: 1⁄4-1⁄2" Seed Spacing: 24 to 36 " Row Spacing: 36" Thinning: Not necessary

HARVESTING INFO

Harvest: When the tomato is 1/2 green and 1/2 pink. It will continue to ripen once picked. Keep in cool place to allow ripening,

Fruit: Clusters of medium sized 8 oz deep red fruit that are uniform in size.
