SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Not Recommended.

Start Inside: Start seeds indoors in peat pots about 8 weeks before the last expected spring frost. Plant pepper seeds 1/4" deep and keep the soil at 80-85 degrees F until germination; provide sunlight or a grow light for 12-16 hours a day. Transplant when 3" tall.

Days to Emerge: 10 - 14 days

Seed Depth: ¼"
Seed Spacing: 18"
Row Spacing: 2.5'
Thinning: Not required.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Pick when full size, about 3 to 4 inches. Fruit will be sweeter if you wait until they turn red.

Fruit: 4" green, turning to red.
