
CHERRY BELLE

Radish

Cherry Belle is a round, crunchy, crisp bright cherry red radish with an outstanding flavor. Heirloom. Open-pollinated.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Raphanus sativus* "Cherry Belle" Plant Dimensions: 2 ¹/₂ "–3" tops and 3/4"–1" rounded root Days to Maturity: 24 Zone: 3-9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: RECOMMENDED. 4 to 6 weeks before your average last frost date, and when soil temperature is above 40°F, ideally 65°–85°F. Successive Sowings: Every 1 to 2 weeks until late spring. Sow again in late summer until 4 weeks before your average first fall frost date.

Start Inside: Not recommended; roots sensitive to disturbance.

Days to Emerge: 5–10 days Seed Depth: ½" Seed Spacing: 1" Row Spacing: 12" Thinning: When 1" tall, thin to 2" apart

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Harvest when radish is no larger than 1½" in diameter. If allowed to grow bigger, 'Cherry Belle' may become pithy and hot.

Fruit: Tops grow 3 - 4 inches and can be used in salads when small.
