SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: 4 to 6 weeks before your average last frost date for a summer crop, or 10 to 12 weeks before your average first fall frost date for a fall crop. When to **Start Inside:** RECOMMENDED. 6 to 8 weeks before your average last frost date, transplanting 2 to 4 weeks before your average last frost date. For fall crop, 4 to 6 weeks before transplanting outdoors in summer. Ideal soil temperature for germination is 75°–85°F.

Days to Emerge: 7 - 12 days

Seed Depth: 1/4"
Seed Spacing: 24"

Row Spacing: 24" - 36"

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Cabbage heads are ready when they're firm to the touch, and when the interior is fairly dense. Heads will split when they're allowed to overly mature. Fruit: 6"- 8" heads, 3 – 4 lbs. The heads are very dense, and the interior leaves are a creamy, greenish white.
