
# **EASTER EGG BLEND**

### **VARIETY INFO**

**Botanical Name:** Raphanus sativus "Easter Egg Blend" **Plant Dimensions:** 5"–8" tops, 1" globe-shaped roots

Days to Maturity: 30

**Zone:** 3-9

#### **SOWING INFO**

**Sow Outside:** RECOMMENDED. 4 to 6 weeks before your average last frost date, and when soil temperature is above 40°F, ideally 65°F. Successive Sowings: Every 1 to 2 weeks until late spring. Sow again in late summer until 4 weeks before your average first fall frost date.

Start Inside: Not recommended; roots sensitive to

disturbance.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days

Seed Depth: ½"
Seed Spacing: 1"
Row Spacing: 12"

Thinning: When 1" tall, thin to 2" apart

#### **GROWING INFO**

**Harvesting:** Harvest when radish is no larger than 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter. If allowed to grow bigger, Easter Egg may become pithy and hot.

Fruit: Red, purple, pink, and white round radishes.
