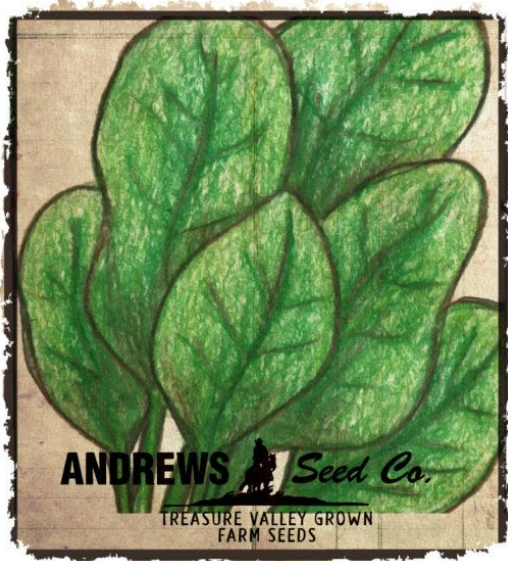


GIANT NOBEL

Spinach

Giant Noble spinach is a very tender and succulent variety with a thick pillowy texture. Prized for its large leaves that are easy to clean and prepare, Giant Noble spinach features a mild and easily palatable spinach flavor that's slightly sweeter than standard spinach.



NOTES

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Spinacia oleracea*

Plant Dimensions: 25"

Days to Maturity: 45

Zone: 3-9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Spinach requires 6 weeks of cool weather from seeding to harvest, so sow seeds directly into the soil as soon as the ground warms to 40°F.

(Cover the soil with black plastic to speed its warming.)

Start Inside: Although seeds can be started indoors, it is not recommended, as seedlings are difficult to transplant.

Days to Emerge: 7-14 days

Seed Depth: ½"

Seed Spacing: 4"

Row Spacing: 4-6"

Thinning: When seedlings sprout to about 2 inches, thin them to 3-4 inches apart. You can eat the thinnings.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Harvest a few outer leaves from each plant (so that inner leaves can develop) when leaves reach desired size, or harvest the entire plant, cutting the stem at the base.

Don't wait too long to harvest or wait for larger leaves. Bitterness will set in quickly after maturity.
