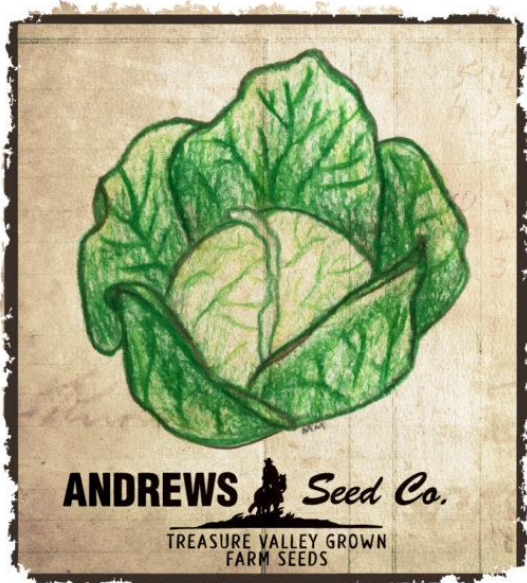


GOLDEN ACRE

Cabbage

The most popular variety for the home garden – our best seller! Their solid, 3-4 lb. heads are the perfect size- not too big, not too small. The plant is also more compact, making it nice for smaller garden spaces. They mature early and have a sweet flavor perfect for fresh eating and cooking!

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Brassica oleracea*

Plant Dimensions: 6" – 7"

Days to Maturity: 62

Zone: 3 – 9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: In spring when soil temperature reaches at least 60°F. Sow 2-3 seeds every 15-18" apart for small headed varieties, 24-36" for large headed varieties. Thin to the strongest seedling per space. Sow in early summer for fall crops.

Start Inside: Start seeds indoors 6-8 weeks before last killing frost in spring. When 4" tall, transplant outside.

Days to Emerge: 7 – 12

Seed Depth: 1/4"

Seed Spacing: 12"

Row Spacing: 24"

Special Instructions: Heirloom cabbage will do well in heavy clay soil, although it prefers a rich heavy loam. It loves to be planted in areas where large amounts of composted manure have been worked into the soil bed. Remember not to plant cabbage seed in the same place year to year. It prefers a soil pH between 6.0 and 7.5.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Reaching maturity in about 60-65 days, Golden Acre cabbages are often among the first cabbages to be harvested from the garden in the spring.

Fruit: 6" – 7" diameter, 2 – 3 lbs.
