SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Space 36 to 42 inches apart. Soil requirements: Provide well-drained, nutrient-rich soil that's high in organic matter. Work at least 3 inches of organic matter into planting beds—more is better. Soil should be at least 70°F at planting.

Start Inside: As they require a long growing season, melons are best started indoors approximately 3 weeks prior to the last frost of the season. Sow seeds ½" deep in flats or small pots, sowing 3 seeds per pot. Keep medium moist while awaiting germination.

Days to Emerge: 3 to 5 days Seed Depth: 1/2" Seed Spacing: 12"

Row Spacing: 36" - 42"

Thinning: Not necessary

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Harvest when rind changes from graygreen to yellow-buff and the netting pattern becomes more pronounced. Look for a crack at the base of the stem. Should slip right off the vine.

Fruit: 3 to 5 pounds.
