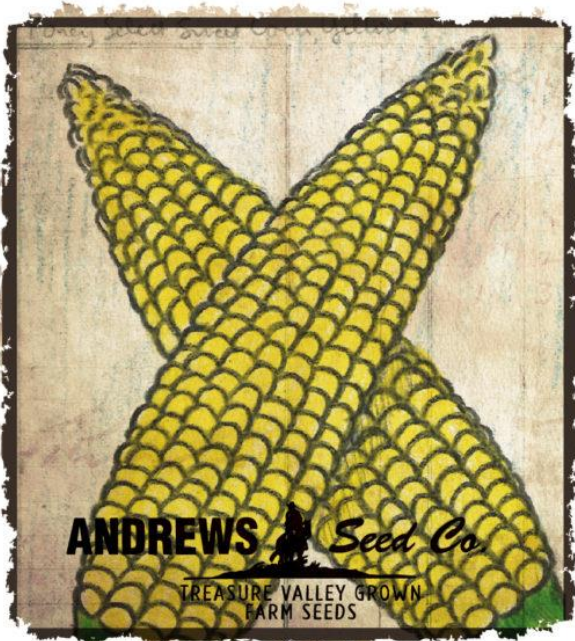


HONEY SELECT

Sweet Corn

Honey Select Sweet Corn is a triple sweet, sugary-enhanced hybrid with tender, flavorful and sweet kernels. It has 75% sugary-enhanced kernels, and 25% super sweet kernels, making it the perfect combination of corn flavor and sweetness.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Mays var "Honey Select"*

Plant Dimensions: 6 ft - 6 ft 6 in

Days to Maturity: 79

Zone: 4-8

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: In late spring, after the last frost date, when the soil reaches at least 60°F. Sow 4-6" apart. Plant in blocks, 4-5 rows, 24-36" apart to aid with pollination. Corn is pollinated by wind therefore planting in blocks ensures proper pollination rather than one long single row where the pollen can easily blow away resulting in small, poorly filled out ears.

Start Inside: Not Recommend.

Days to Emerge: 7-10 days.

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 4-6"

Row Spacing: 24-36"

Thinning: Thin to 10-12" apart.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Ready for picking 2 1/2 - 3 weeks after silks appear. Silks become dry and brown. The kernels should be plump and full. Test by pressing your fingertip into a kernel, looking for a "milky" appearance. Best picked in the morning and refrigerate/cool right away.

Fruit: Plants produce large, 8" ears that are filled to the tip.
