VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: Cucurbita pepo "Jack Be Little"

Plant Dimensions: 3'-5' vines

Days to Maturity: 95

Zone: 3-9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Sow 4–5 seeds per hill when weather has warmed after danger of frost. Allow 4–6' between hills.

Start Inside: Start indoors three weeks before setting out. Do not disturb the roots. Transplant 30" apart.

Days to Emerge: 7-14 days

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 2-3 seeds per mound

Row Spacing: 3'-4'

Thinning: Thin seedlings to 2-3 per group when they

are 1-2 inches high.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Harvest pumpkins before the first fall frost, and when foliage has begun to dry out. Cut stem with a knife, leaving 3"–4" of stem on the pumpkin. Brush off any dirt or leaves. Ideally, cure at 80°-85°F and 80–85% humidity or a warm, sunny spot with good air circulation for 1 to 2 weeks before eating or storage. Do not allow harvested fruit to get wet.

Fruit: 3-4" wide and 2" high. Great for decorations both

inside and out
