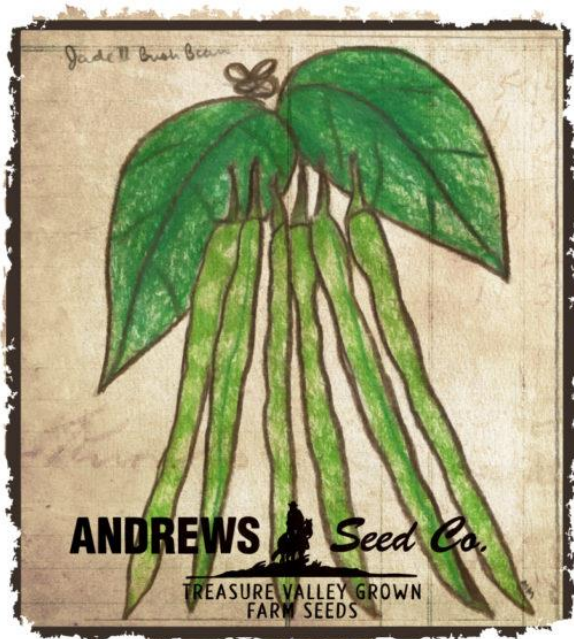


JADE II

Bush Bean

Jade Bush Beans are productive, reliable and disease resistant, This stringless, jade-green bean is a market gardener's dream with home garden flavor! Plants set many long straight pods.



NOTES

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Phaseolus vulgaris* 'Jade II'

Plant Dimensions: 22" - 28"

Days to Maturity: 60

Zone: 3 - 9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Direct sow beans in the garden 1 to 2 weeks after the last expected frost when the soil has warmed to at least 60°F.

Start Inside: Start beans indoors 3 to 2 weeks before transplanting to the garden.

Days to Emerge: 6 - 10 days

Seed Depth: 1/2" to 1".

Seed Spacing: 1"

Row Spacing: 24" - 36"

Thinning: Plant 1 inch apart and thin to 2-3 inches apart. Plant in rows 24- 36 inches apart. Depth: 1/2 to 1 inch. ... Fruit: 6 1/2 Inch, dark green, straight pods.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Pick regularly when pods are 4-6" (10-15cm), before sides bulge.

Fruit: 6.5", dark green, straight pods. Stringless.
