GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Corn is best harvested it early in the morning. Grasp the ear firmly and pull down, then twist and pull. Cobs usually come off the stalk easily. Harvest only as much as you can eat in a day for the first few days, but ensure you harvest the entire crop while it is in the milky stage.

Fruit: 8-inch yellow ears. 14- 16 rows per ear.
