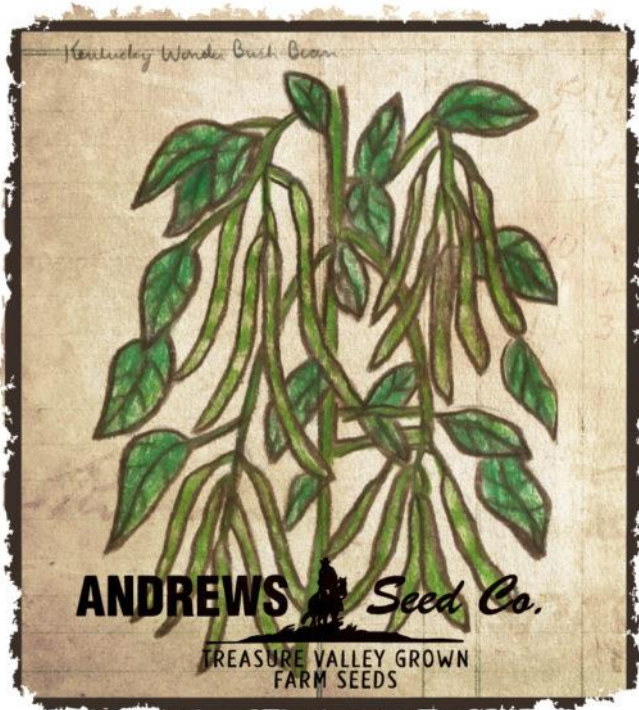


# KENTUCKY WONDER

## Bush Bean

Kentucky Wonder Bush Beans are a stringless bean with tender, oval, thick pods that are meaty and tender with an amazing flavor! This variety is a standard for the home and market gardener and produces heavy yields over an extended growing season. Tender, stringless, plump, fleshy 8" pods have excellent flavor. Bush habit, snap, 65 days.

### VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Phaseolus vulgaris*

Plant Dimensions: 18"

Days to Maturity: 57

Zone: 3 - 9

### SOWING INFO

**Sow Outside:** Direct sow seeds outside at least 1 week after the last frost. Plant in rich, well-drained soil with full sun exposure. Plant in 2 to 3 weeks intervals for a steady harvest.

**Start Inside:** Start beans indoors 3 to 2 weeks before transplanting to the garden.

Days to Emerge: 7 - 10 Days

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 3-5"

Row Spacing: 2"

Thinning: Not required.

### GROWING INFO

**Harvesting:** Pick Kentucky Wonder pole beans when the bean pods are smooth and fat, but before they begin to turn lumpy. The beans will be between 7 and 9 inches long. Continue picking beans every two or three days to ensure that the plants continue to produce a harvest through the entire season

**Fruit:** 7" - 8" long
