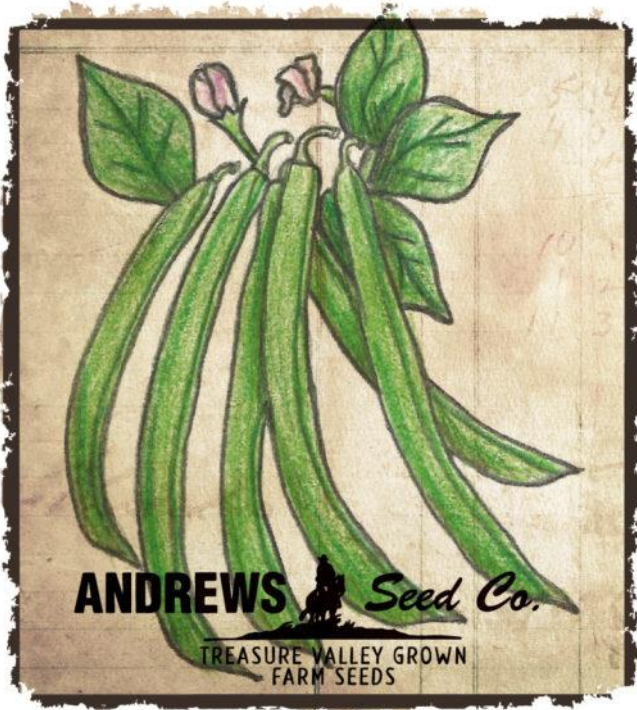


LANDRETH STRINGLESS

Bush Bean

Landreth Stringless Bean is an heirloom, open-pollinated bush bean variety that was introduced in 1885. This bush bean variety is truly stringless and fiber less. Upright plants are hardy and grow to 20-24" tall. Pods average 5" and are slightly curved.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Phaseolus vulgaris*

Plant Dimensions: 20" - 24"

Days to Maturity: 60-75

Zone: 3 - 9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Direct sow Landreth stringless bush green bean seeds outside at least 1 week after the last frost, since beans are quite sensitive to cold. They should be planted in rich, well-drained soil with full sun exposure

Start Inside: Start beans indoors 3 to 2 weeks before transplanting to the garden.

Days to Emerge: 8 - 16 Days

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 2"

Row Spacing: 24"

Thinning: Not required.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Expect your first beans about ten weeks after germination. Daily harvesting improves production; for best flavor and tenderness, pick the beans when they are no larger than a pencil in thickness, or from 4-8" long.

Fruit: 5" pods
