SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Not Recommended. Start Inside: 4-6 weeks before the last killing frost, plant into a growing tray: Fill each spot with soil leaving a quarter inch at the top. Put 2-3 seeds per container then sprinkle soil on top. Keep soil moist but not soaked. Transplanting is best done 1 to 2 weeks after the average date of the last frost for your region. When transplanting, tomatoes like to be planted deeper than Days to Emerge: 5-10 days Seed Depth: 1/4-1/2" Seed Spacing: 18-36" Row Spacing: 36" Thinning: Not necessary

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: When the tomato is 1/2 green and 1/2 pink is when you can start harvesting your tomato. It will continue to ripen once picked. Keep in cool place to allow it to ripen without damaging the fruit or losing flavor or nutrients.

Fruit: 1 1/4" diameter, red.
