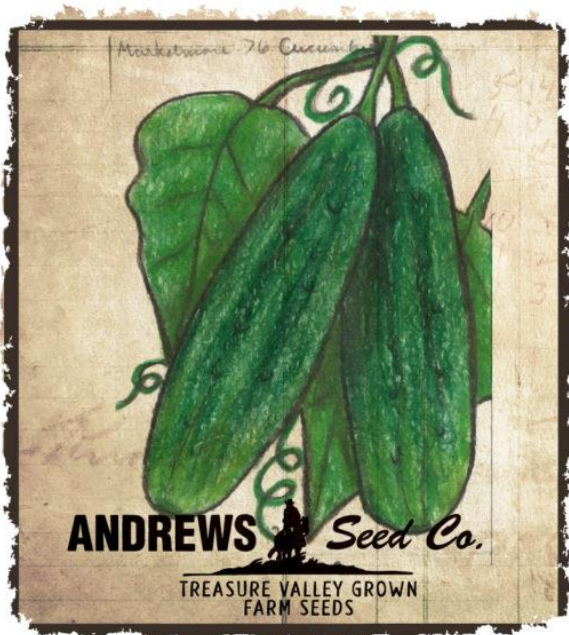


MARKETMORE 76

Cucumbers

Marketmore 76 is an excellent open-pollinated slicer cucumber for its quality and yield potential. This plant produces an abundance of medium length 8-10 inches long cucumbers with dark green skin weighing 8-12 ounces. Its skin is slightly bumpy and can be left on or taken off for slicing and fresh eating.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Cucumis sativus*

Plant Dimensions: 4 FT

Days to Maturity: 70

Zone: 3-12

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: For direct seeding, wait until soil is warm, at least 70°F. Cucumber seeds will not germinate at a soil temperature below 50°F. Sow 2-3 seeds/ft., 1/2" deep, in rows 6' apart. Thin to 12" apart.

Start Inside: For transplanting, sow indoors in at 1-2 seeds per cell, 3-4 weeks before transplanting. Thin to 1 seedling per cell when true leaves form. Keep temperature above 70°F day and 60°F at night.

Transplant 12" apart in rows 5-6' apart. Do not disturb roots when transplanting. Peat pots work best to reduce stunting and transplant shock.

Days to Emerge: 7-14 Days.

Seed Depth: 1/2"

Seed Spacing: 12"

Row Spacing: 6'

Thinning: Not necessary

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Once fruit bearing begins, pick daily to ensure steady harvest.

Fruit: Medium length 8-10 inches long cucumbers with dark green skin weighing 8-12 ounces.
