

PEACHES & CREAM (MID)

Sweet Corn

Tender, sweet kernels have a creamy texture that stores well until eaten. A gourmet bicolor sweet corn that consistently delivers good yields. A long-time favorite of gardeners, that is good for fresh eating or home freezing. Bicolor kernels. Medium green husks.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Zea mays* "Peaches & Cream (Mid)"

Plant Dimensions: 5'-6' tall stalks

Days to Maturity: 85

Zone: 2-10

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: RECOMMENDED. Do not soak corn seeds prior to planting. Plant 2-5cm (1-2") deep (shallower for sh2 seed or in cool soil). Sow seeds around 7.5cm (3") apart, in rows 60-90cm (24-36") apart. Because corn is wind pollinated, plant in a dense block of at least 4 rows, rather than in single rows. This increases the chance of corn pollen.

Start Inside: Not recommended; roots sensitive to transplanting. Best results occur when seedlings are transplanted less than 2 weeks old.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days.

Seed Depth: 1"-1 ½"

Seed Spacing: A group of 2 seeds every 12"-18"

Row Spacing: 24"-36"

Thinning: When 4" tall, thin to 1 every 12"-18"

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: When the silks at the end of an ear are a dry brown, the cob seems to start to droop, and the kernels release milky juice when cut.

Fruit: This fantastic mid-season bicolor hybrid produces 8.5" long cobs, each with 18-20 rows each of white and gold kernels. The kernels produce two different flavors in every bite.
