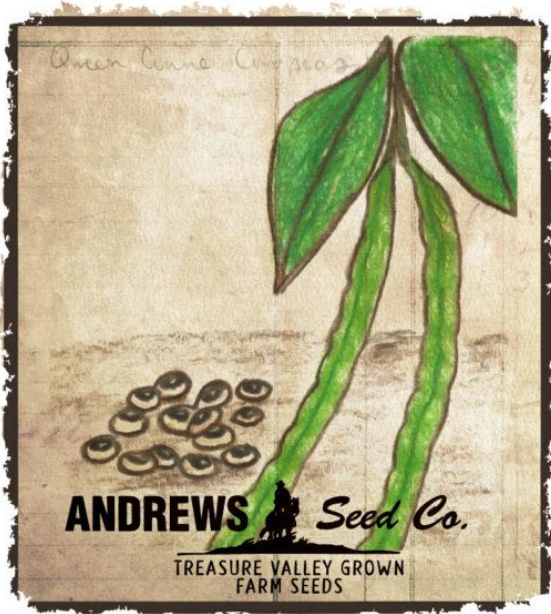


# QUEEN ANNE

## Cowpeas

Queen Anne' is a very dependable and heavy producer. Yields 8 to 12 seeds per 7 to 9" pod. Plants are compact, 26 " tall with no runners. Highly recommended for green shell or dry use, freezing, or canning. Can be grown in most northern states.

### VARIETY INFO

**Botanical Name:** *Vigna unguiculata*

**Plant Dimensions:** 26 " tall

**Days to Maturity:** 68

**Zone:** 5-11

### SOWING INFO

**Sow Outside:** Sow when soil has warmed to at least 60°F, which is normally about four weeks after the last frost date. Cover the soil with polythene prior to planting in early spring, and then protect tender seedlings with a fleece. Germination can take from 9 days (60°F) to five weeks (40°F). Make successive plantings through to late spring.

**Start Inside:** Not recommended.

**Days to Emerge:**

**Seed Depth:** 1"

**Seed Spacing:** 3-4"

**Row Spacing:** 3-4'

**Thinning:** Not necessary

### GROWING INFO

**Harvesting:** Cowpeas can be harvested at any time, but are most often used as a green mature bean. Also grown and used as a dried bean. Frequent harvesting also encourages plant to produce more pods.
