


QUICKIE

Sweet Corn

Quickie gets its name for being one of the earliest corns to mature. This variety is a great tasting bi-color corn that displays well. Quickie has cold-soil vigor for short-season areas. Quickie corn has a nice flavor with lasting sweetness and tenderness.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Zea mays* "Quickie"

Plant Dimensions: 5 Feet.

Days to Maturity: 68

Zone: 3-9

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Plant corn in several short rows, not in one or two long rows. Plant the corn seeds about 1 inch deep and 3 to 4 inches apart in the row. Space the rows 2½ to 3 feet apart. After the plants are up, thin them to 1 foot apart.

Start Inside: Not recommended.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days.

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 6 - 12"

Row Spacing: 30 - 36"

Thinning: Thin to 1' apart.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Sweet corn should be harvested at the milk stage. At this stage the silks are brown and dry at the ear tip. When punctured with a thumbnail, the soft kernels produce a milky juice. Over-mature sweet corn is tough and doughy.

Fruit: 7", 14-row ears.
