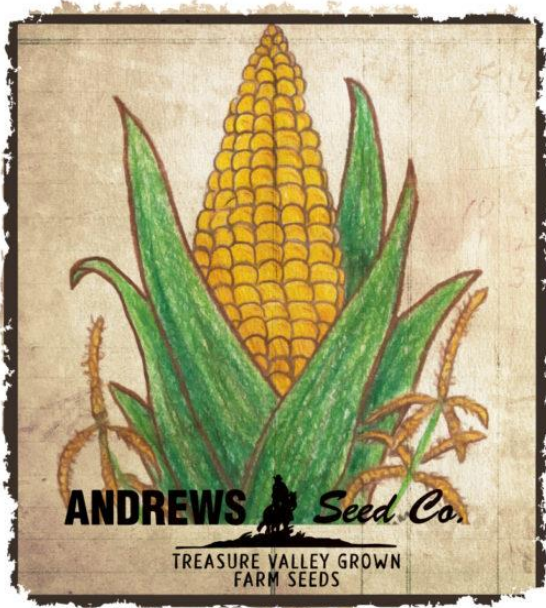


SERENDIPITY

Sweet Corn

Serendipity produces mouthwatering, tender, bicolor kernels with a perfect balance between sugary sweet and traditional corn flavor. The Serendipity corn is a new type of corn offering 2 kernel types - 75% sugar enhanced and 25% super sweet.

VARIETY INFO

Botanical Name: *Zea mays "Serendipity"*

Plant Dimensions: 6 ft tall

Days to Maturity: 82

Zone: 3-12

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Sow seeds after the last frost, when the soil temperature has reached a minimum of 60 degrees Fahrenheit. Corn is a warm weather crop and the seeds will be slow in germinating in colder soil temperatures. Plant the seeds a half-inch deep in cooler soil, 1 1/2 inches deep for warmer soil.

Start Inside: Not Recommended.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days.

Seed Depth: 1"

Seed Spacing: 6-8"

Row Spacing: 30 - 36"

Thinning: Not required.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Ready for picking 2 1/2 - 3 weeks after silks appear. Silks become dry and brown. The kernels should be plump and full. Test by pressing your fingertip into a kernel, looking for a "milky" appearance. Best picked in the morning and refrigerate/cool right away.

Fruit: Ear size: 8 x 1.9", Kernel rows: 16-18
