SOWING INFO

Sow Outside: Sow 2 inches apart in double rows spaced 6 inches apart with 24 inches between each set of rows. Cover with 1 inch of fine soil, and sow 1 inch deep. Thin gradually to stand 4-6 inches apart starting when seedlings are about 1-2 inches high.

Start Inside: Not Recommended.

Days to Emerge: 10 Days Seed Depth: 1 - 1-1/2"

Seed Spacing: 2" Row Spacing: 18-24"

Thinning: 3 to 4 inches apart.

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Peas will be ready to harvest in six to eight weeks from sowing. Harvest them when the pods are green and still tender, and the peas inside are just starting to swell. Snap off the tough ends and pull off any strings, and eat the entire pods or just the peas inside.

Fruit: 3-5"
