"Super Sioux" tomatoes are bright red in color, usually between 2 and 4 inches in diameter and weigh 4 to 6 ounces each. The fruits have smooth skin and are thick-walled, with relatively small seed cavities.

SOWING INFO

Sow Outside:

Start Inside: Start indoors 6 to 8 weeks before your last frost date, sowing 1 or 2 seeds in each peat pot or planting cell. Use sterile potting soil or a soil-less mix to minimize damping off, a fungal problem in young seedlings. Transplant 2/3 of plant into soil for strong root development.

Days to Emerge: 5-10 days

Seed Depth: 0.25"

Seed Spacing: 18 to 30" Row Spacing: 3 or 4"

GROWING INFO

Harvesting: Tomatoes generally ripen 6–8 weeks after fruit set. Tomatoes will continue to mature even after they have been harvested. Harvest fully ripe fruits when they have full color but are still firm.

Fruit: 2 and 4 inches in diameter and weigh 4 to 6 ounces each. The fruits have smooth skin and are thick-walled, with relatively small seed cavities. Their flavor is typical of an old-fashioned tomato, with sweetness mixed with an acidic "bite."
