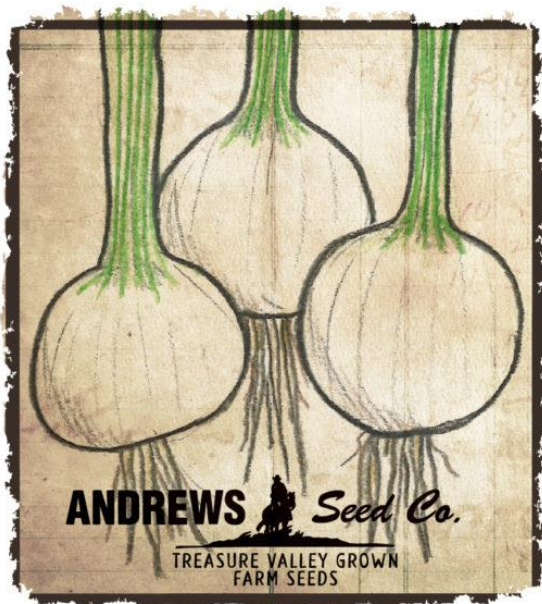


# WHITE SPANISH SWEET, RINGMASTER

## Onions

Easy to peel and with a mild, sweet flavor, this onion produces large white bulbs that continue to impress some of our fiercest onion consumers. Ringmaster White Sweet Spanish Onion gives gardeners a large globe with single centers and a firm, mild flesh. Ringmaster also stores well and can be grown in short day areas for early green onions. Favorite choice for onion rings!



## NOTES

### VARIETY INFO

**Botanical Name:** *Allium cepa*

**Plant Dimensions:** 2-6"

**Days to Maturity:** 90-120

**Zone:** 2-9

### SOWING INFO

**Sow Outside:** Not recommended.

**Start Inside:** For best results, onion seeds should be started indoors in flats and transplanted out of doors when seedlings are between 4-6 inches tall, taking care not to damage the roots. Onion seeds will germinate best in warm soil, between 68-75 degrees, with consistent moisture. When setting seedlings, actual root depth will depend on the length of root, but usually between 1.5 and 2 inches, making sure that most of the white of the stem is planted along with the root. Seedlings should be set at least 2-3 inches apart. Onions will thrive in moderate temperatures with consistent moisture. It is important to not let your onion plot dry out completely.

**Seed Depth:** 1/4"

**Seed Spacing:** 2"

**Row Spacing:** 12-18"

### GROWING INFO

**Harvesting:** When bulbs have started to "fatten up," gently pull them out of the ground. If your plants have started to bolt, harvest and use immediately.

**Fruit:** Up to 5" diameter
