**Sow Outside:** 3–4 weeks before average last frost date. For a fall crop, start 10–12 weeks before average first frost date.

Seed Spacing: 6"
Row Spacing: 18"

Thinning: Not necessary

#### **GROWING INFO**

**Harvesting:** For optimum flavor and texture, harvest when the bulbs are 2 to 3 in. across. We recommend sowing this cold crop every two weeks for a successive harvest. Early White Vienna Kohlrabi is a cool-weather crop and can be sown directly into the garden for a spring or fall crop.

**Fruit:** Up to 12" inches high. The pale green, flattened, globe shaped bulbs are smooth and tender and form above the ground. The uniquely flavored white flesh of this Kohlrabi is tastes the best when bulbs are 3" in diameter.
